Judges Assistants

- Responsible for entering the scores into the iPad to display the results on the monitor
- This can be someone under the age of 18, provided they are confident and capable of fulfilling their duties.

Canteen

- Responsible for assisting with the cooking and serving of canteen food
- Handling cash and eftpos facilities (Square POS)

Raffle Staff

• Sell and promote raffle tickets and items to spectators (using cash, Eftpos can only be taken by designated staff at either Canteen or Uniform Shop)

Toilet Cleaner

Clean the toilets in between each session.

Scorers, floor manager and other roles will be covered by PCGC staff and committee members.

Numbers

Athletes will be given a pin on number at registration prior to their session (time indicated on workplan). Parents must provide their own safety pins, and a penalty of \$10 will apply if numbers are not returned

Uniforms

Uniform requirements for this event are as per the 2025 Competition Handbook. Failure to wear the correct uniform will incur a deduction for your child's routines.

A summary of our uniform requirements are below:

MAG ATHLETES

- PCGC Leotard PCGC,
- clean competition longs
- PCGC shorts (same color as longs)
- Clean, socks
- PCGC Polo
- Underwear must be skin colour, and not visible (deductions apply)
- Hair must be gelled back, off the face, and suitable for rolls, etc Make sure you are using strong gel

WAG ATHLETES

- Level 1-3 Short Sleeved leotard Level 4+ Long Sleeved Leotard
- PCGC Polo (all levels)
- PCGC Shorts (optional)
- Competition scrunchie is to be used in athletes hair
- Hair is to be the same as the image below
- Underwear must be skin coloured, and not visible (deductions apply)
- All athletes must have clean feet, removed nail polish and no jewellry is permitted during a competition.

These requirements are the responsibility of YOU, not coaches or other parents!
